IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING SNOWDEN LANE & VAN DYKE ROAD SEWER WORK

On Monday, November 21, and through Wednesday November 23th, weather permitting, ICUNJ will continue the restoration of the Snowden Lane asphalt surface disturbed by construction activities. To facilitate this work, Snowden Lane will be closed between Herrontown Road and Overbrook Drive during the working hours of 7AM to approximately 5PM for each day. This schedule is subject to change. Detours will be posted at appropriate locations according to location of work.

No work will occur on Thursday November 24th or Friday November 25th.

Work on Snowden Lane will block access to individual driveways when work is directly in front of your residence for approximately 2 hours. When work is scheduled to be in front of your residence on Snowden Lane, please park on the south side of Van Dyke Road. After the work passes your house, you will again be able to park in your driveway.

For residents on Snowden Lane, please have your garbage and recycling ready the night before the pick-up day as the hauler has been requested to do a pick-up prior to ICUNJ begins work at 7AM.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
