IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING SNOWDEN LANE & VAN DYKE ROAD SEWER WORK

On Monday December 5th and through Tuesday December 6th, ICUNJ will restore the asphalt surface of Snowden Lane disturbed by construction activities. To facilitate this work, Snowden Lane will be closed to through traffic between Herrontown Road and Overbrook Drive during the working hours of 7AM and approximately 5PM for each day. This schedule is subject to change. Detours will be posted at appropriate locations according to location of work.

Work on Snowden Lane may restrict access to individual driveways for approximately 2 hours when work is directly in front of your residence. Residents needing to access their driveways during work hours should contact Rich Decker, Princeton Project Inspector, who can assist in accommodating individual needs. Rich Decker will be on site during construction activities.

For residents of Snowden Lane please have your garbage and recycling ready the night before the pick-up day as the hauler has been requested to do a pick-up prior to ICUNJ begins work at 7AM.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic at the end of each work day. Provisions will be made for emergency service vehicles and for continued services such as mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
