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IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING SNOWDEN SANITARY SEWER WORK BETWEEN OVERBROOK DRIVE AND VAN DYKE ROAD

On Monday, September 19th through Friday, September 23rd, ICUNJ will continue with installation of the sanitary sewer main on Snowden Lane between Overbrook Drive and Van Dyke Road. **While this work is proceeding, Snowden Lane will be closed to through traffic between Overbrook Drive and Van Dyke Road during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm.**

The work will necessitate trenching in the southbound lane of Snowden Lane, blocking access to individual driveways. Please note the access to the driveways will be blocked for approximately 8 hours when the work is directly in front of each property. Residents should park on Overbrook Drive, or on the south side of Van Dyke Road when the work is in front of their property. This should only be for one day, during work hours. After the work passes your house, you will again be able to park in your driveway.

For residents on Snowden Lane between Overbrook Drive and Van Dyke Road, please have your garbage and recycling ready the night before the pick-up day, as the hauler have been requested to do a pick-up prior to ICUNJ work start at 7 am within the road closure area.

NJAW has completed the water main installation on Snowden Lane between Franklin Avenue and Overbrook Drive. Testing is underway for the newly installed water main. Once the testing is complete, the existing services will be connected to the new main. No work is anticipated for the week of September 19th. Additional notice will be provided to the affected residents prior to start of this work. Additional notice will be provided by NJAW to the affected residents. Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
