

Snowden Lane sewer project update 10-3-16

Please note ICUNJ will continue with installation of the sanitary sewer main on Snowden Lane between Overbrook Drive and Van Dyke Road and later in the week on Snowden Lane north of Van Dyke Road. Installation of sewer on Van Dyke Road is now scheduled after the sewer installation is completed on Snowden Lane. While this work is proceeding, Snowden Lane will be closed to through traffic between Overbrook Drive and Van Dyke Road during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm. Later in the week, when the work proceeds on Snowden Lane north of Van Dyke Road, Snowden Lane will be closed between Van Dyke Road and Herrontown Road during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm.

The work will necessitate trenching in the southbound lane of Snowden Lane, blocking access to individual driveways. Please note the access to the driveways will be blocked for approximately 8 hours when the work is directly in front of each property. Residents should park on Overbrook Drive, or on the south side of Van Dyke Road when the work is in front of their property. This should only be for one day, during work hours. After the work passes your house, you will again be able to park in your driveway.
