**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING SNOWDEN SANITARY SEWER WORK
BETWEEN VAN DYKE ROAD AND HERRONTOWN ROAD**

On Monday, October 10th and through Friday, October 14th, weather permitting, ICUNJ will continue with installation of the sanitary sewer main on Snowden Lane between Van Dyke Road and Herrontown Road. While this work is proceeding, Snowden Lane will be closed to through traffic between Van Dyke Road and Herrontown Road during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm.

The work will necessitate trenching in the southbound lane of Snowden Lane, blocking access to individual driveways. Please note the access to the driveways will be blocked for approximately 8 hours when the work is directly in front of each property. Residents should park on the south side of Van Dyke Road when the work is in front of their property. This should only be for one day, during work hours. After the work passes your house, you will again be able to park in your driveway.

On Wednesday, October 12th, weather permitting, ICUNJ will install sanitary sewer in the intersection of Snowden Lane and Van Dyke Road. While this work is proceeding, Snowden Lane will be closed to through traffic between Overbrook Drive and Herrontown Road, and additionally, Van Dyke Road will be closed between Snowden Lane and Meadowbrook Drive during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm. No driveways will be affected as part of this work.

For residents on Snowden Lane between Van Dyke Road and Herrontown Road, please have your garbage and recycling ready the night before the pick-up day, as the hauler has been requested to do a pick-up prior to ICUNJ work start at 7 am within the road closure area.

**NJAW WATER MAIN IMPROVEMENTS WORK
BETWEEN FRANKLIN AVENUE AND OVERBROOK DRIVE**

NJAW is proceeding with replacement of house water services within the public right-of-way and connection of these services to the new water main on Snowden Lane between Braeburn Drive and Overbrook Drive. **On Monday, October 10th and through Friday, October 14th, weather and scheduling permitting, NJAW's contractor, CRJ Construction plans to continue the replacement of house water services within the public right-of-way, between Braeburn Drive and Overbrook Drive. While this work is proceeding, Snowden Lane will be closed to through traffic by-block between Braeburn Drive and Overbrook Drive during the working hours of 9 am to approximately 4 pm.** The switchover to the new house water service will require shut-off of the water for approximately 30 minutes and is typically done one house at a time between the hours of 9 am and 3 pm. Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
