IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK BETWEEN EWING STREET AND WITHERSPOON STREET

The Municipality of Princeton has contracted with ICUNJ to construct roadway; sidewalk; curb; sanitary sewer; drainage; signage and striping improvements on Valley Road between North Harrison Street and Witherspoon Street. More information is available regarding this project at:

On Monday, May 9th, weather and scheduling permitting, ICUNJ plans to begin the replacement of the sanitary sewer main and services within the public right-of-way between Ewing Street and Witherspoon Street. To provide for this work, Valley Road will be closed from Ewing Street to Witherspoon Street during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm. Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. This first phase of the work is expected to be completed within 4 to 6 weeks' time. The entire project, including top soil and seeding, is expected to be completed by the end of September. You will receive additional notice within the next week regarding continuation of the NJAW water services installation work between Walnut Lane and North Harrison Street.

Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. There may be times when access to your driveway will be closed; we will endeavor to provide 24-hour notice when this will occur. During construction, Valley Road through traffic will be detoured onto Terhune Road.

Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up. The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic and parking at the end of each work day.
