**IMPORTANT NOTICE**  
**INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALK ALONG THE NORTHERN SIDE OF VALLEY ROAD**  
**BETWEEN JEFFERSON STREET AND WITHERSPOON STREET**

As part of the Valley Road Improvement project, a new 4' concrete sidewalk will be installed along the northern side of Valley Road from Jefferson Road to Witherspoon Street. In preparation for the sidewalk installation, which is planned for mid to the end of June, the sidewalk location has been marked in white paint along the affected properties. The sidewalk will be placed within the right-of-way (right-of way line is located approximately 17' from edge of pavement), and away from trees and tree roots to the extent feasible. Minimal tree and brush removal will be completed prior to the installation of the sidewalk. Tree replanting will be scheduled for Fall 2016 and Spring 2017. **If you have plantings that you would like to keep along your property that will interfere with the sidewalk installation as marked, please arrange to have them removed. The plantings may be replanted a minimum distance of 3' behind the proposed sidewalk.**
