IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK BETWEEN WALNUT LANE AND JEFFERSON ROAD AND JEFFERSON ROAD AND HARRIS ROAD

On Monday, June 6th and Tuesday, June 7th, weather permitting, ICUNJ will be doing emergency sewer repair work on Guyot Avenue between Carnahan Place and Witherspoon Street.

On Wednesday, June 8th, weather permitting, and through the rest of the week, ICUNJ plans to continue the sanitary sewer repairs on Valley Road between Walnut Lane and Harris Road. **To provide for this work, Valley Road will be closed to through traffic by block between Walnut Lane to Jefferson Road and Jefferson Road to Harris Road during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm.**

Just a reminder the recycling is rescheduled for this Saturday, June 4th. Please have your bins out by 7 am on the morning of the pick-up date.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
