IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK BETWEEN WALNUT LANE AND WITHERSPOON STREET

On Saturday, June 25th, ICUNJ plans to complete the storm drainage pipe repairs on Valley Road between Jefferson Road and Witherspoon Street utilizing the trenchless replacement technique by inserting a new pipe into the existing pipe. Noise and vibrations are experienced in the immediate vicinity of the work during this process. We continue to express our sincerest apologies and really appreciate your patience in tolerating the noise and vibrations. **To provide for this work, Valley Road will be closed to through traffic between Jefferson Road and Witherspoon Street during the working hours of 8 am to approximately 5 pm. Some driveways will be temporarily blocked by staging of the pipe prior to insertion. A paper notice will be delivered to your door one day prior to notify you of this.** No work will take place on Sunday, June 26th. Tom Hughes, Manager of Infrastructure and Operations will be on-site during this work.

On Monday, June 27th and through Friday, July 1st, ICUNJ will continue with the storm drainage spot repairs through excavation between Walnut Lane and Witherspoon Street. **Valley Road will be closed to through traffic by block between Walnut Lane to Jefferson Road and Jefferson Road to Witherspoon Street during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm.** The Valley Road Princeton Public Schools Administration building will be accessible from Witherspoon Street only while the roadway is closed.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
