IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK BETWEEN WALNUT LANE AND WITHERSPOON STREET

Please note the work will be restarting on Valley Road. The contractor, ICUNJ, will return on Monday, July 18th and through Friday, July 22nd, will continue with the storm drainage spot repairs through excavation between Walnut Lane and Witherspoon Street. Tree removal of the previously marked trees on the north side of Valley Road between Jefferson Road and Witherspoon Street is also scheduled for the week of July 18th. **Valley Road will be closed to through traffic by block between Walnut Lane to Jefferson Road and Jefferson Road to Witherspoon Street during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm.** The Valley Road Princeton Public Schools Administration building will be accessible only from Witherspoon Street while the roadway is closed.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
