IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK BETWEEN EWING STREET AND WITHERSPOON STREET

On Monday, July 25th and through Friday, July 29th, ICUNJ will continue with the storm drainage spot repairs between Walnut Lane and Witherspoon Street. Tree removal of the previously marked trees on the north side of Valley Road between Jefferson Road and Witherspoon Street was started and will continue the week of July 25th. Also on Monday, July 25th, Lancha Construction Corporation, a subcontractor to ICUNJ for concrete work, plans to begin replacement of sidewalk, curb ramps and installation of concrete driveway aprons on Valley Road, beginning just east of Walnut Lane and continuing towards Witherspoon Street. **Valley Road will be closed to through traffic, by block, between Ewing Street to Witherspoon Street during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm.** The Valley Road Princeton Public Schools Administration building will be accessible from Jefferson Road or Witherspoon Street while the roadway is closed. The replaced sidewalk on westbound side of Valley Road between Harris Road and Jefferson Road will be installed 1 foot away from the roadway to promote pedestrian safety.

The sidewalk on westbound side of Walnut Lane between Valley Road and Hickory Court is also included in sidewalk replacement and is planned for the week of July 25th. **When this work is proceeding, Walnut Lane will be closed to through traffic between Valley Road and Hickory Court during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm.**

When concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons are installed at your driveway, access to your driveway will be prohibited for 48 hours. Please park in a legal space on a nearby side street. We will notify you when access is restored to your driveway.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
