IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK BETWEEN EWING STREET AND WITHERSPOON STREET

On Monday, August 1st and through Friday, August 5th, ICUNJ will continue with storm drainage spot repairs between Ewing Street and Jefferson Road. Installation of drainage header pipe on Valley Road near Ewing street is also planned for the week of August 1st. In addition, on Monday, August 1st, Lancha Construction Corporation, a subcontractor to ICUNJ for concrete work, will continue the replacement of sidewalk, curb ramps and installation of concrete driveway aprons on Valley Road, on westbound side of Valley Road between Jefferson Road and Witherspoon Street. **Valley Road will be closed to through traffic, by block, between Ewing Street to Witherspoon Street during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm.** The Valley Road Princeton Public Schools Administration building will be accessible from Jefferson Road or Witherspoon Street while the roadway is closed. The replaced sidewalk on westbound side of Valley Road between Harris Road and Jefferson Road will be installed 1 foot away from the roadway to enhance pedestrian safety.

When concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons are installed at your driveway, access to your driveway will be prohibited for 48 hours. Please park in a legal space on a nearby side street. You will be notified when access is restored to your driveway.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
