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### **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK BETWEEN EWING STREET AND WITHERSPOON STREET**

On Monday, August 8<sup>th</sup> and through Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, ICUNJ will continue with storm drainage spot repairs between Ewing Street and Jefferson Road and will install top soil and seed the areas disturbed by the installation of the sidewalk. In addition, on Monday, August 1<sup>st</sup>, Lancha Construction Corporation, a subcontractor to ICUNJ for concrete work, will continue the installation and replacement of sidewalk, curb ramps and installation of concrete driveway aprons on Valley Road, on eastbound side of Valley Road between Jefferson Road and Ewing Street. Also on Monday, August 8<sup>th</sup> and through Wednesday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, SWERP, Inc., a subcontractor to ICUNJ for sanitary sewer lining work, will be lining the existing sanitary sewer main on Valley Road between Jefferson Road and Walnut Lane. The lining technology allows a new pipe to be installed inside the existing sanitary sewer line without roadway excavation. Please be advised that this lining technique does create an odor. This odor can get into your home if your sanitary sewer lateral is improperly ventilated, traps are not working correctly or if floor drains are connected to the sanitary sewer lateral. The odor is not harmful. A paper notice is provided to the homes that will be directly affected by the sanitary sewer lining work.

**While this work is proceeding, Valley Road will be closed to through traffic, by block, between Ewing Street to Witherspoon Street during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 4 pm. The Valley Road Princeton Public Schools Administration building will be accessible from Jefferson Road or Witherspoon Street while the roadway is closed.**

**When concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons are installed at your driveway, access to your driveway will be prohibited for 48 hours. Please park in a legal space on a nearby side street. The residents whose driveways will be directly affected by this work will be notified via paper notice.**

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
