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### **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK BETWEEN WITHERSPOON STREET AND NORTH HARRISON STREET**

On Monday, August 29<sup>nd</sup> and through Friday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>, ICUNJ will continue with installation of top soil and seed in the areas disturbed by the installation of the sidewalk, storm drainage, and sewer. **While this work is proceeding, Valley Road will be closed to through traffic, by block, between Witherspoon Street and North Harrison Street during the working hours of 7 am to approximately 5 pm.** Please note the milling and paving of Valley Road is on hold due to Executive Order 210, which allows for the New Jersey American Water Company to finish the water main on Harris Road prior to paving. Additional notice will be provided prior to start of milling and paving work.

Please note the straw is spread to keep the grass seed down and to keep the moisture on the grass seed once it rains. The straw should be kept on the grass seed until the grass seed sprouts, about 1-2 inches. You can mow the grass once the new grass reaches 2-3 inches. We request residents frequently water the seeded areas in the absence of rain until grass becomes well established.

### **NEW JERSEY AMERICAN WATER COMPANY WORK HARRIS ROAD BETWEEN VALLEY ROAD AND GUYOT AVENUE**

Starting today, August 26<sup>th</sup>, CRJ Excavating, New Jersey American Water (NJAW) company's contractor will be working on Harris Road between Valley Road and Guyot Avenue during the hours of 7 am and 5 pm (Monday – Friday). The work is anticipated to continue for 3 to 4 weeks. If you have any questions regarding NJAW work, please contact Mr. John Thomas, NJAW Construction Inspector, at 609-380-7367.

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Residents are advised to use caution when driving within the road closure area and allow additional time for travel. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles and for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.
