**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING VALLEY ROADWAY WORK  
BETWEEN N. HARRISON STREET AND WITHERSPOON STREET**

**On Tuesday, November 8<sup>th</sup> through Friday November 11<sup>th</sup> contractor, S. Brothers, plans to mill and pave the base layer of asphalt on Valley Road from N. Harrison Street to Walnut Lane. To provide for this work, Valley Road will be closed to traffic in multiple block groupings between N. Harrison Street and Witherspoon Street during the working hours of 7 AM to approximately 5 PM. The intersections of Valley Road with N. Harrison Street and Witherspoon Street will remain open.** Milling and paving the base layer of asphalt on Valley Road will take approximately four (4) days to complete. The work will begin at N. Harrison Street and continue west towards Witherspoon Street.

*Due to weather restrictions, the paving of the top layer of asphalt on Valley Road (from Witherspoon Street to N. Harrison Street), Hickory Court, Harris Road and the intersection of N. Harrison Street with Valley Road is delayed until Spring 2017.*

**The milling and paving work will restrict access to individual driveways. Please note the access to driveways will be restricted for approximately 8 hours when the work is directly in front of your property. On November 8<sup>th</sup>, residents between N. Harrison Street and Walnut Lane should park on Ewing Street or Walnut Lane prior to start of the work day, 7 AM. Residents needing to access their driveways during work hours should contact Rich Decker, Princeton Project Inspector, who can assist in accommodating individual needs.** As work progresses, a notice will be distributed to those affected residents of Valley Road on a daily basis. The Valley Road Princeton Public Schools Administration building will be accessible only from Witherspoon Street when work is directly in front of the building. Rich Decker, Princeton Project Inspector, will be on-site during this work.

**For all residents of Valley Road, please have your garbage, organics and recycling ready the night before the pickup day as the hauler has been requested to do a pick up before 7AM. All residents are also kindly requested to wait until completion of this work before placing Brush, Logs and Leaves curbside.**

Should inclement weather occur, the work will proceed the following business day. The roadway will reopen at the end of each work day. Provisions will be made for emergency services vehicles.
