Important Notice

Dear Snowden Lane Neighborhood Residents:

A neighborhood meeting will be held on May 21, 2013 to discuss and coordinate the installation of a new 8" water main along Snowden Lane between Nassau Street and Franklin Avenue.

The meeting has been scheduled for 7:00 PM in the Main meeting room of the Municipal Building, 400 Witherspoon Street. All interested residents are invited to attend.

The items to be discussed at the meeting include the plan and construction schedule for the new 8" watermain and service lateral installations to be completed by New Jersey American Water. Once the work is completed the project will include the full width resurfacing of Snowden Lane.

Princeton Council Member Jenny Crumiller, representatives from the Engineering Department, Police Department, the New Jersey American Water Company and the Water Company's contractor, will be available to discuss the project and answer any questions you may have.

Residents are advised that the Municipality will be imposing a 5-year moratorium on any street openings once the work is completed. Therefore, if you plan to upgrade or install new utility services such as gas, water, electric, etc., you should contact the respective utility company at this time to make the necessary arrangements.

I invite you to attend this meeting to view the proposed improvement plans and to discuss any concerns you may have regarding this project.
