Public Health Advisory: CDC and NJ Department of Health confirm suspected case of measles

After additional review of laboratory tests, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the New Jersey Department of Health have confirmed the suspected case of measles at Princeton University. The student has recovered and is no longer infectious.

The Princeton Health Department is working closely with the New Jersey Department of Health and Princeton University to monitor persons potentially exposed between Wednesday, February 4 and Sunday, February 8. No locations off campus have been identified as being visited by the student confirmed with measles.
