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## IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING PARK PLACE, VANDEVENTER AVENUE, WIGGINS STREET, MOORE STREET, AND WILLOW STREET

Next week, Montana Construction will return to the southern section of Vandeventer Avenue to complete the installation of New Jersey American water service connections and meter pits between Park Place and Nassau Street. Vandeventer Avenue between Nassau Street and Park Place will be closed from 7 am to 6 pm Monday through Friday to accommodate this work.

Monday and Tuesday, weather permitting, ICUNJ will set up, and then enlarge the existing pipe and install a new pipe within the sanitary sewer main on Park Place between Vandeventer Avenue and Madison Street. This operation will require the fusing of approximately 300 feet of plastic pipe above ground before it is inserted through the existing pipe underground. Prior to installation, the fused pipe will be temporarily stored at or near the northern curb line of Park Place. When the installation takes place on Tuesday, weather permitting, Vandeventer Avenue, south of Spring Street and Madison Street at Park Place will be closed. Please note the work may proceed into the evening due to the complexity of the operation. **If you live on Park Place between Vandeventer Avenue and Madison Street you will be asked to refrain from washing clothes, running your dishwasher and/or discharging other sources of sewage on Tuesday until the work is completed that evening.** The Park Place parking lot will be accessible from Park Place, via Moore Street, during this time. If you live on Park Place or Madison Street, you will not be able to exit your neighborhood via Vandeventer Avenue or Spring Street while the work is proceeding.

Also on Monday and Tuesday, between 8:30 am and 2:30 pm, Lancha Construction will be replacing concrete curb at the intersection of Wiggins Street / Hamilton Avenue and Moore Street. Please allow extra time if you need to drive through this intersection while the curb work is taking place.

Wednesday through Friday, weather permitting, the contractor, ICUNJ will move its operations to the intersection of Park Place and Moore Street to begin work on storm sewer and sanitary sewer improvements. The Park / Moore intersection will be closed during work hours until the contractor is completed with the replacement work.

Also on Wednesday through Friday, Lancha Construction will work to complete concrete sidewalk repairs on Moore Street between Franklin Avenue and Spruce Street. If time permits, Lancha may begin sidewalk replacement work on Vandeventer Avenue; if this occurs, additional notice will be provided. Please note, you will not be able to drive over the new concrete for 24 - 48 hours.

Adjacent properties on the affected street(s) will be notified as needed to remove vehicles prior to the start of work each day. Parking will be allowed in non-metered, legal parking spaces on other municipal roads where work will not be taking place. If you need to park your car on the street overnight, please contact Chris Knigge, [cknigge@princetonnj.gov](mailto:cknigge@princetonnj.gov), to obtain a temporary parking placard, which must be placed on the dashboard of the driver's side front windshield.

Provisions will be made for continued services such as mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up. The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic and parking at the end of each work day.
