IMPORTANT NOTICE

Dear Westerly Road Neighborhood Residents:

On Monday, April 15, 2013, weather permitting, Integrated Construction and Utilities of New Jersey, the Township's Contractor, is planning to repave the sections of driveways that were damaged during construction. The work is planned to begin at 7:00 AM and is anticipated to be completed by the end of the day Friday, April 19th, weather permitting.

During this time, residents should be prepared to remove vehicles from their driveways. Residents will be allowed to park on Westerly Road, Wilson Road and Pardoe Road where work is not taking place. Vehicles should not be parked near or across from driveways in order to allow access for the paving machines. In the event of inclement weather, the work will proceed on the following work day.

Work hours will be between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM. Access to driveways will be restricted after the work is completed to allow the asphalt to cool and set. In this regard, it is recommended that you not drive your vehicle over the asphalt for a 24 hour period to allow it to cure. Provisions will be made for continued services such as mail delivery, garbage and recycling pick-up.

You will receive an additional notice prior to the milling and paving of the street.
