The Town of Princeton has been advised by Avalon Bay that they are going to begin cleaning out the inside of the former Princeton Hospital/Medical Center building on Franklin and Witherspoon Streets. The work being done is non-permit required work and will consist of removal of doors, carpet, wallpaper, decorative panels, curtains, any remaining office furniture and partitions, nursing stations, moldings, ceiling tiles, kitchen equipment and other items.

The town wanted to advise the residents of the commencement of this limited scope of work. This work will require dumpsters to be brought on site as well as some trucks transporting workers and their light equipment. The building will remain secured.

The Council will continue to discuss other matters including the projects Developer's Agreement as well as certain elements of the demolition plan including testing requirements before and during the demolition phase of the project. This discussion is set to occur at a meeting set for April 7, 2014.
