IMPORTANT NOTICE
NJDOT TREE PLANTING PROJECT

The Municipality of Princeton has partnered with the New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) to participate in the "Good Neighbor Program" which is focused on improving aesthetics along State roadways. Proposed work includes: planting twenty eight (28) new trees; removal of trees in poor condition; grinding of tree stumps; and closing or increasing the size of certain tree pits. The work will occur on Stockton Street (US Route 206) and Nassau Street (NJ Route 27) extending from Library Place to Pine Street on both sides of the street.

Beginning on Tuesday, May 3, 2016 at 7:00 am, NJDOT's contractor, VIP, Inc., will start the project work at Library Place and proceed toward Pine Street. Work hours are 7 am to 6 pm, Monday through Friday. Should severe weather conditions be encountered, this work will be rescheduled for the same work hours on subsequent business days. The contractor anticipates to be completed with this project by May 15th.

In order to provide for this work, parking spaces will be unavailable for use at different locations along the roadways for the duration of the work day. Princeton Police Department officers will be on-site to maintain traffic movement through the work zone.
