Public Health Advisory: Princeton University provides update on suspected measles case

Princeton University has received a report of an undergraduate student with a suspected case of measles. Preliminary results were received on Tuesday, Feb. 17, and additional tests are being conducted. Those results are expected in the next few days. The student has recovered and is no longer contagious.

The Princeton Health Department is working closely with the New Jersey Department of Health and Princeton University to locate persons potentially exposed between Wednesday, February 4 and Sunday, February 8. At this time, no locations off campus have been identified as being visited by the student currently suspected with measles.
