To apply for a US Passport, residents will need 1) Proof of US citizenship in the form of a state certified birth certificate, a US naturalization certificate or a previous US Passport. 2) Proof of identity in the form of a current driver's license or state issued identification card. A US Passport is valid for ten years for adults and five years for minors. The cost for a passport is \$110 for adults and \$80 for minors plus a processing fee of \$25. The federal government requires a separate check for each passport application. Passport photos will be taken on-site for \$15 or \$10
