## IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MERCER ROAD WORK

Tomorrow, June 4th, weather permitting, the remainder of Mercer Road work is scheduled to begin. The work is expected to be completed by June 14th, weather permitting. This work will consist of driveway apron resurfacing, installation of belgian block curbing at Hale Drive and a small portion of concrete curb on Mercer Road at Quaker Road, leveling and final surfacing of the section of the Mercer Road between Quaker Road to the Lawrence Township line. While this work is proceeding, Mercer Road will be closed to through traffic from Province Line Road to Quaker Road between the hours of 9 am to approximately 7 pm, weekdays only.

The work will start with sawcutting the keyways at driveways and intersections on Wednesday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, beginning at the Lawrence Township line and proceed toward Quaker Road. On Thursday, June 5<sup>th</sup>, curbing will be installed at the locations indicated above. On Friday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, driveways and intersections are scheduled to be paved, weather permitting, starting at the Lawrence Township line and proceeding towards Quaker Road. The new driveway and intersection pavement will need approximately 2 hours to cure. We request that when the paver gets to your driveway, please make accommodations either by moving your vehicle to an alternate close-by location, such as Gallup Road, Hale Drive or Hutchinson Drive, or refrain from using your driveway to allow the pavement to cure. Beginning June 9th, weather permitting, we will proceed with leveling Mercer Road, followed by final paving.

The final paving is currently planned for June 12<sup>th</sup>, +/- 1 day, weather permitting. You will receive additional notice prior to the final paving.

Provisions will be made for continued services such as brush collection, mail delivery, garbage, recycling pick-up and school bussing during this phase of the work. The road will be reopened to full two-way traffic at the end of each work day and will remain open until the start of next work day.

The repair of Quaker Road in the area of the D&R Canal is planned to be done after the Mercer Road work is completed. You will receive additional notice prior to that work proceeding.
