

## What Do I Do With? ...

Household Item	Disposal Location
<b>Appliances</b>	<b>Convenience Center on River Road</b> A permit is necessary to access the center and must be obtained at the Princeton Sewer Operating Committee, Monument Hall, One Monument Drive. (Any item with Freon must have the Freon removed prior to disposal; a small appliance repair man can do this for you or you can pay an additional \$30 for a special permit available at Monument Hall) Call 609-497-7639 for further information.
<b>Automobiles</b>	<b>Wheels for Wishes</b> The NJ Chapter of the Make A Wish Foundation will pick up your automobile and issue a charitable tax deduction. Call 1-877-712-9474 or visit their website <a href="http://newjersey.wheelsforwishes.org/">http://newjersey.wheelsforwishes.org/</a>
<b>Batteries - Alkaline (dry cell) i.e., AAA, AA, A, C, D &amp; 9 volt</b>	<b>Dispose with your regular household trash.</b> <b>DO NOT RECYCLE</b>
<b>Batteries - Car and Boat (wet cell)</b>	<b>Mercer County Household Chemical Waste Disposal Day</b> <b>OR</b> Check with local repair facilities to see if they accept or turn it in when you get a new battery.
<b>Batteries - Rechargeable and batteries less than 2 lbs. (watch, cell phone)</b>	Drop off container at locations such as Radio Shack, Lowe's, Home Depot and Sears

<b>Cell Phones</b>	<b>Drop off container located in the Princeton Police Department lobby</b> All related equipment is accepted including batteries and chargers.
<b>Computers (CPU's, laptops &amp; monitors only)</b>  Due to changes in legislation, Princeton is no longer able to accept electronics or other computer related items. <b>Insecticides, Insect Repellents</b>	<b>Mercer County Household Chemical Waste Disposal Day</b> Call 609-278-8086 or <a href="http://www.mcyanj.org">www.mcyanj.org</a>
<b>Mattresses and Box Springs</b>	<b>Trash with your bulky waste</b> Mattresses and box springs must be wrapped in plastic for disposal.
<b>Packing Paper</b>	<b>RECYCLE</b> Place in YELLOW recycle container for curbside collection on scheduled recycle day
<b>Packing Peanuts</b>	<b>Trash</b> <b>OR</b> Call a local shipping outlet to see if they will accept. <b>DO NOT RECYCLE</b> They also make a great drainage aid for your container plants.
<b>Paint – Enamel or oil based paint, paint thinners and turpentine</b>	<b>Mercer County Household Chemical Waste Disposal Day</b> Call 609-278-8086 or <a href="http://www.mcyanj.org">www.mcyanj.org</a>
<b>Paint – Latex Only</b>	<b>Trash</b> Remove lid, air dry the can or fill with sand or kitty litter prior to placing out for refuse collection. <b>DO NOT RECYCLE</b>

<b>Pizza Boxes</b>	<b>Trash or GREEN ORGANIC CART</b> <b>DO NOT RECYCLE</b>

<b>Plastic Flower Pots and Flower Flats</b>	<b>Trash</b> <b>OR</b> Return to the place of purchase <b>DO NOT RECYCLE</b>
<b>Pool Chemicals</b>	<b>Mercer County Household Chemical Waste Disposal Day</b> Call 609-278-8086 or <a href="http://www.mcyanj.org">www.mcyanj.org</a>
<b>Prescription Medications</b>	<b>Princeton Police Department - Project Medicine Drop Box</b> 1 Valley Road Princeton, NJ 08540 (609) 927-2100 Open 24/7, 365 days/year Accepts solid pharmaceuticals such as pills, capsules, patches, inhalers, and pet medications. They cannot accept syringes or liquids (Sharps must be destroyed and placed in a hard, plastic bottle with a warning label which may then be placed in the trash. <b>OR</b> Call the University Medical Center of Princeton at Plainsboro at (609) 853-7000 to ask about their syringe return program). <b>DO NOT RECYCLE OR FLUSH MEDICATIONS</b>
<b>Scrap Metal</b>	Refer to the Yellow Pages for local scrap metal yards. Many will pay for the metal.
<b>Styrofoam</b>	<b>Trash</b> <b>OR</b> Call a local shipping outlet to see if they will accept. <b>DO NOT RECYCLE</b> It also makes a great drainage aid for your container plants.

Household Item	Disposal Location
<b>Syringes</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Trash</b></p> <p>Clip needles with a needle clipper and place in a hard plastic container (detergent or soda bottle) with a tightly sealed top. Place a large WARNING label on the container and dispose with household trash.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>OR</b></p> <p>Call the University Medical Center of Princeton at Plainsboro at (609) 853-7000 to ask about their syringe return program.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>DO NOT RECYCLE</b></p>
<b>Take Out Containers – Plastic, Styrofoam, Cardboard</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Trash or GREEN ORGANIC CART for Cardboard containers only</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>DO NOT RECYCLE</b></p>
