
Cold Weather Alert!

Please be advised we will be experiencing extreme cold weather over the next few days. Temperatures will be in the teens with wind chills taking the temperatures below 0. The following is the forecast for the next two days:

- Thursday a slight chance of snow showers after 1pm. mostly cloudy, with a high near 22. Wind chill values as low as -9. West wind 6 to 11 mph. Chance of precipitation is 20%.
- **Thursday Night** Partly cloudy, with a low around 7. Wind chill values as low as -3. Northwest wind 6 to 9 mph.
- **Friday** Sunny, with a high near 21. Wind chill values as low as -4. West wind 9 to 13 mph.
- **Friday Night** Partly cloudy, with a low around 16. Southwest wind 6 to 9 mph.

2. Witherspoon Hall, Located at 400 Witherspoon Street. Please utilize the main entrance and you will find the warming station in the community room. The hours of operation will be 9AM to 5PM Friday January 24, 2014
3. Princeton Senior Resource Center, 45 Stockton Street, Please utilize the main entrance and you can ask for information at the front reception desk. The hours of operation will be 9AM to 5PM Thursday January 23, 2014 and 9AM to 5PM Friday January 24, 2014
4. Princeton Public Library, Sands Library Building, 65 Witherspoon Street. The main lobby opens at 7:00 AM and the library proper opens at 9:00 AM and closes at 9:00 PM, please utilize the main entrance.
