The items listed are no longer allowed to be placed on the curb for trash collection and will NOT be collected by our trash hauler.

## What can be recycled for FREE

All computers, monitors, laptops, portable computers and televisions are accepted for free recycling. Please note that other electronic devices (keyboards, mice, printers, microwaves, etc.) are not included in this free program. Please check with your local collection site to determine if they will accept your other electronic device.

The town of Princeton accepts electronic waste at the two (2) sites listed below,

- 1. Princeton Public Works on Valley Road across from the Police Station accepts ALL electronics for recycling by appointment. Please call (609) 688-2566 to arrange a drop off time.
- 2. The Convenience Center on River Raod accepts T.V.'s and computer monitors for free. Call (609) 497-7639 for hours of operation.

It is illegal to dump Electronic Waste after the metals are removed, VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED under, N.J.D.E.P. Regulation N.J.A.C. 7:26A-13
