Re: Transco / Williams Gas Pipe Line Project

Dear Neighborhood Resident:

You are invited to attend a meeting on Tuesday, March 24, 2015 at 7:00 PM in the main meeting Room of the Princeton Municipal Building at 400 Witherspoon Street. The purpose of this meeting is to discuss the Transco / Williams Gas Pipe Line project that involves the installation of a new 42" gas pipeline within the existing easement running between Coventry Farm and Cherry Valley Road and crossing Stuart Road, White Oak Drive and Ridgeview and Cherry Valley Roads.

Tree removal work along the easement could start as early as the end of March and the pipeline construction work is currently planned to start around May 1st.

Items to be discussed at the meeting include the planned construction schedule of the project; how, when and where various items of work will be completed and who you should contact if you have any concerns as the work proceeds.

Representatives of Transco / Williams and Henkles and McCoy, the project contractor, will be in attendance. In addition, representatives of the Police Department, Engineering Department and Emergency Services along with the Municipal Arborist will be available to discuss the project and answer any questions you may have.
