**STOPPING OR STANDING OF MOTOR  
VEHICLES AND AMENDING THE  
"CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968"**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton  
as follows:

1. Sec. 11-39 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968"  
which regulates the stopping or standing of motor vehicles in no stopping  
or standing zones is amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 11-39. Stopping or standing.**

No person shall stop or stand a vehicle at any time in any no  
stopping or standing zone.

2. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected to enforce this motor  
vehicle regulation as required by the New Jersey Department of  
Transportation.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided  
for by law.
