AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING APPLICATION FEES AND ESCROW DEPOSITS FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION PLAN APPROVAL AND AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY 1968"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

1. Section 10B-36(a) of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which establishes application fees and escrow account deposit requirements for land development applications is amended as it pertains to Historic Preservation plan applications and shall read as follows:

	Fee	Escrow
Preservation Plan which is part of application for development	\$ 50.00	No amount other than what is required for the application for development
Preservation Plan which is not part of an application for development	\$ 50.00	No escrow for plans approved pursuant to Section 10B-41.2(b); \$150.00 for all others.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, publication and the filing of a copy of the Ordinance with the Mercer County Planning Board, all of which is required by law.
