AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE PROHIBITION FOR RIGHT TURNS FROM CHERRY VALLEY ROAD ONTO HEATHER LANE AND AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968"

WHEREAS, in 1998 the Township of Princeton established a prohibition of right turns from Cherry Valley Road onto Heather Lane in order to eliminate Heather Lane as a cut through from Cherry Valley Road to the Great Road; and

WHEREAS, in 2006 the intersection of Cherry Valley Road and the Great Road has been improved with the installation of a traffic control signal and designated turning lanes; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2007 Princeton Township Safety Officer Sgt. Thomas R. Murray, III conducted a traffic survey at the intersection of Cherry Valley Road and Heather Lane and has determined that as a result of the aforementioned improvements at the intersection of Cherry Valley Road and the Great Road right turns onto Heather Lane from Cherry Valley Road during the morning rush hour have decreased dramatically.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

1. Section 11-5 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which prohibits right turns from various streets within the Township is amended by deleting therefrom the following designation:

Cherry Valley Road. Onto Heather Lane.

2. Any signage currently prohibiting right turns from Cherry Valley Road onto Heather Lane shall be removed by the Princeton Township Police Department.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.
