**AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWNSHIP OF
PRINCETON, COUNTY OF MERCER, STATE
OF NEW JERSEY CONCERNING
PENALTIES FOR MOTOR VEHICLE AND
TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS AND AMENDING
THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968"**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of the Princeton as follows:

1. Section 11-7 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which establishes maximum penalties for violation of motor vehicle and traffic regulations is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11-7. Penalty.

Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Chapter shall be liable to a penalty of not more than one thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars or by imprisonment for a term not exceeding fifteen (15) days or both.

2. Pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 39:4-197*, this Ordinance shall be submitted for review and approval to the New Jersey Department of Transportation before it become effective.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, publication and the above-referenced approval by the New Jersey Department of Transportation, all of which is provided for by law.
