**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
PARKING REGULATIONS WITHIN
FARM VIEW FIELDS AND
AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY, 1968".**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton
as follows:

1. Article II, Chapter 11 regulating motor vehicle stopping, standing and parking is amended by adding thereto a NEW Division 11 concerning the Farm View Fields parking yard and shall read as follows:

Division 11. Farm View Fields Parking Yard.

As used in this small division, "Farm View Fields parking yard" means that certain parking yard in and belonging to the township and located within the Farm View Fields adjacent to Great Road.

Sec. 11-23.18.12. Parking from Dawn to Dusk.

No persons shall park any vehicle between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. in the Farm View Fields parking yard.

Sec. 11-23.18.13. Use of Parking Yard.

No person shall park any vehicle in the Farm View Fields parking yard at any time except while on business in the Farm View Fields or participating in Recreation Board sponsored activities within the park.

Sec. 23.18.13. Parking Within Stalls Required;

Other Regulations.

No person shall park any vehicle at any time in the Farm View Fields parking yard except within a parking stall designated by pavement markings thereon.

No person shall allow any vehicle to stop or stand along the westerly curb of the Farm View Fields parking yard at any time where indicated.

No person shall engage in the loading or unloading of passengers or equipment from a vehicle so as to obstruct any driveway or any no stopping or standing zone within the Farm View Fields parking yard.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.
