

2009-4 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AS A GENERAL IMPROVEMENT THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE STONY BROOK PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE AND PATHWAY BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$789,692.00 THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton:

1. The Township of Princeton (hereinafter referred to as the "Municipality") is hereby authorized to undertake and complete the construction of the Stony Brook Pedestrian Bridge and Pathway in accordance with plans and specifications currently on file in the Office of the Princeton Township Engineering Department and hereby approved by the Township Committee.
2. The work, acquisition or improvement authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be undertaken as a general improvement, the entire cost of which shall be contributed and borne by the Municipality as a general expense and paid for through various grants and funding sources heretofore received and as set forth in Section 4 of this Ordinance, and no part of said costs shall be specially assessed against any property.
3. It is hereby determined and stated that the undertaking of the aforementioned work, acquisition or improvement (hereinafter referred to as "Purpose") is not a current expense of the Municipality and that the estimated cost of said Purpose is \$789,692.00.
4. The Municipality has received various Federal and State grants totaling \$789,692.00 for the Purpose set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance as follows:
 - A. Transportation Enhancement Program: \$500,000.00

B.	Livable Communities PILOT Program:	\$ 78,000.00
C.	Recreation Trails Program:	\$ 21,692.00
D.	NJDOT Local Aid Bikeway Program:	<u>\$190,000.00</u>
		<u>\$789,692.00</u>

Consequently, no funds from the Township's Capital Improvement Fund need to be utilized for this Capital Project.

5. The Capital Budget of the Municipality is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this Ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.
6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.
