

**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING  
LOADING ZONES AND AMENDING  
THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF  
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968".**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton as follows:

1. Chapter 11 of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" is amended by adding thereto the following NEW Section 11-19.2.1 concerning loading zones and shall read as follows:

**Sec. 11-19.2.1            Loading Zones; Mondays.**

The following areas upon the municipally controlled streets of the township are hereby designated as loading zones between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Mondays:

John Street.    East side, starting at a point a distance of one hundred and nine (109') feet from the northern curb line of Leigh Avenue and proceeding a distance of fifty-five (55') feet northerly therefrom.

2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Princeton Township Committee held on January 25, 2010 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Township Committee to be held at the Princeton Township Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street, on February 8, 2010 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
