AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A THIRTY-FIVE (35) MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT ON CHERRY VALLEY ROAD AND AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Princeton, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Sec. 11-2(b) of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which established forty (40) mile per hour speed limits on roadways within the Township concerning the designation for Cherry Valley Road be and the same is hereby deleted.

Section 2. Sec. 11-2(a) of said Code which established thirty-five (35) mile per hour speed limited on roadways within the Township is amended by adding thereto the following NEW designation for Cherry Valley Road and shall read as follows:

CHERRY VALLEY ROAD, eastbound, from Province Line Road to Route U.S. 206, except twenty-five miles per hour when passing through the Princeton Montessori School zone during recess, when the presence of children is clearly visible from the roadway, or when the children are going to or leaving school during opening or closing hours.

Section 3. Pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 39:4-8*, the Office of Princeton Township Engineer has certified to the Township Committee that the reduction of the speed limit on Cherry Valley Road from forty (40) miles per hour to thirty-five (35) miles per hour as referenced hereinabove is appropriate after an investigation has been undertaken by said Office and the Princeton Township Traffic Safety Committee and it appears both to the Engineer and the Committee that it is in the interest of safety and the expedition of traffic on Cherry Valley Road to implement said speed reduction.

Regulatory and warning signs as prescribed by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, as adopted and approved by the New Jersey Department of Transportation shall be erected to enforce the above-referenced speed reduction.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the adoption of a reciprocal Ordinance for westbound traffic on Cherry Valley Road from Province Line Road to Route U.S. 206 by the Township of Montgomery, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey, since Cherry Valley Road forms a common boundary line with the Township of Montgomery and they are responsible for regulating the speed of the westbound traffic.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication and upon the adoption of the above-referenced reciprocal Ordinance by the Township of Montgomery, all of which is required by law.

STATEMENT

The bond ordinance published herewith has been finally adopted on September 19, 2011 and the 20-day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement.
