**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
SECTION 2-116 OF THE CODE OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON
CONCERNING THE ANIMAL
CONTROL ADVISORY
COMMITTEE**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 2 (Administration) of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968” is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-116. Animal Control Advisory Committee

There is hereby established an Animal Control Advisory Committee consisting of three residents (“citizen members”), at least one of whom has expertise in biology or animal control; the Animal Control Officer; the Administrator or his or her designee; and a non-voting liaison from the governing body. The citizen members shall be appointed for three year terms except that the initial appointments shall be for a one year term, a two year term and a three year term.
