**AN ORDINANCE BY PRINCETON
ESTABLISHING MID-BLOCK
CROSSWALKS ON ALEXANDER STREET
AND EDGEHILL STREET AND
AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY, 1974".**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-5 of the "Code of the Borough of Princeton, New Jersey, 1972", which establishes mid-block crosswalks is amended to add new mid-block crosswalks on Alexander Street and Edgehill Street in Princeton within this Section and shall read as follows:

Sec. 19-5. Mid-block crosswalks.

(a) Designated. The following portions of municipally controlled streets in Princeton are hereby designated as mid-block crosswalks for pedestrian crossing:

Alexander Street, from a point approximately 1120 feet south of the center of the roundabout at the intersection with University Place extending 8 feet southerly therefrom.

Edgehill Street, from a point approximately 400 feet north of the northerly curb line of Mercer Street extending 6 feet northerly therefrom.

(b) Markings. The mid-block crosswalks hereinabove designated shall be distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by lines or other marking on the surface in conformance to M.U.T.C.D. standards.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.
