

**2015-3 AN ORDINANCE BY PRINCETON
REGULATING PARKING ALONG PORTIONS
OF CLEVELAND LANE AND AMENDING THE
“CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF PRINCETON,
NEW JERSEY, 1974”.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-22 of said Code establishing no parking at any time is amended by deleting existing Cleveland Lane references and replacing with the Cleveland Lane locations as follows:

Sec. 19-22. No parking zones

(a) No parking at any time.

(1) Designated. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following streets or parts thereof:

Cleveland Lane, south side, from Elm Road (County Route 604) to Bayard Lane (US Route 206).

Cleveland Lane, north side, from the east curb of Elm Road to a point two hundred sixty-three feet easterly.

Cleveland Lane, north side, from a point three hundred seventy-five feet east of the east curb line of Elm Road to a point four hundred twenty-five feet east of the east curb line of Elm Road.

Cleveland Lane, north side, from a point two hundred eighty-nine feet west of the west curb of Lafayette Road to a point four hundred twenty-two feet west of the west curb of Lafayette Road.

Cleveland Lane, north side, from the west curb of Lafayette Road to a point forty-eight feet westerly.

Cleveland Lane, north side, from the east curb of Lafayette Road to a point forty-five feet easterly.

Cleveland Lane, north side from the west curb of Library Place to a point sixty-seven feet westerly.

Cleveland Lane, north side from the east curb of Library Place to a point fifty feet easterly.

Cleveland Lane, north side, from a point five hundred seven feet east of the east curb of Library Place to a point six hundred twenty-seven feet east of east curb of Library Place.

Cleveland Lane, north side, from the west curb of Bayard Lane (US Route 206) to a point seventy-five feet westerly.

Section 2. Section 19-23 of said Code establishing nonmetered on-street parking zones is amended by deleting existing Cleveland Lane references and replacing with the Cleveland Lane locations as follows:

(d) Parking time limited to two hours.

(1) No person shall park a vehicle for longer than two hours at any time between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M., Monday through Saturday, upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

Cleveland Lane, north side, from a point seventy-five feet westerly of the west curb of Bayard Lane to a point six hundred twenty-seven feet easterly of the east curb of Library Place.

Cleveland Lane, north side, from a point five hundred seven feet easterly of the east curb of Library Place to a point fifty feet easterly of the east curb of Library Place.

Section 3. The appropriate no parking signs shall be posted to implement this no parking regulation.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the no parking and two-hour nonmetered parking zones on Cleveland Lane in order to correct discrepancies and conflicts in the current ordinances.
