

**AN ORDINANCE BY PRINCETON  
ESTABLISHING MID-BLOCK  
CROSSWALKS ON ALEXANDER STREET  
AND EDGEHILL STREET AND  
AMENDING THE “CODE OF THE  
BOROUGH OF PRINCETON, NEW  
JERSEY, 1974”.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-5 of the “Code of the Borough of Princeton, New Jersey, 1972”, which establishes mid-block crosswalks is amended to add new mid-block crosswalks on Alexander Street and Edgehill Street in Princeton within this Section and shall read as follows (underlined material added):

Sec. 19-5. Mid-block crosswalks.

(a) Designated. The following portions of municipally controlled streets in Princeton are hereby designated as mid-block crosswalks for pedestrian crossing:

Alexander Street, from a point approximately 1120 feet south of the center of the roundabout at the intersection with University Place extending 8 feet southerly therefrom.

Edgehill Street, from a point approximately 400 feet north of the northerly curb line of Mercer Street extending 6 feet northerly therefrom.

(b) Markings. The mid-block crosswalks hereinabove designated shall be distinctly indicated for pedestrian crossing by lines or other marking on the surface in conformance to M.U.T.C.D. standards.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication as provided for by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of Princeton held on June 22, 2015 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held at the Princeton Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street on July 13, 2015 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
