

**AN ORDINANCE BY PRINCETON
REGULATING PARKING ALONG
VALLEY ROAD IN THE VICINITY
OF WITHERSPOON STREET AND
AMENDING THE “CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY, 1968”**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-12 of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey” (Code) establishing no parking zones upon certain streets is hereby amended as follows (additions are underlined):

DIVISION 3. PARKING PROHIBITED

Sec. 11-12. At any time.

No person shall park any vehicle on any of the following streets or parts of streets at any time:

Valley Road. South side, between Ewing Street and Harrison Street North.

Valley Road. South side, from the east curbline of Witherspoon Street to a point 90’ east.

Section 2. The appropriate no parking signs shall be posted to implement the requirements of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, as required by law.

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the no parking zones for Valley Road in the vicinity of the Valley Road School building, in order to facilitate safe turning movements from Witherspoon Street in accordance with endorsements from the Princeton Police Department and the Traffic Safety Committee. The net effect of these changes will be the loss of two parking spaces.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of Princeton held on August 24, 2015 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held at the Princeton Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street on September 15, 2015 beginning at 7:00 p.m.
