

**AN ORDINANCE BY  
PRINCETON ESTABLISHING  
ONE HOUR FREE PARKING IN  
THE SPRING STREET GARAGE  
AND AMENDING THE “CODE  
OF THE BOROUGH OF  
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY,  
1974”.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-32 (b)(1) of the “Code of the Borough of Princeton, New Jersey 1974” (Code) establishing parking fees in the Spring Street Municipal Parking Garage is hereby amended by as follows (additions are underlined; deletions are in [brackets]):

Sec. 19-32. Parking fees.

(b) Spring Street Municipal Parking Garage.

(1) The following rates shall apply to the Spring Street Municipal Parking Garage between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 9:00 P.M., seven days per week, unless otherwise indicated below:

- [a. The first thirty minutes shall be free.]
- [b. For over thirty minutes and up to one hour, one dollar and twenty-five cents.]
  - a. The first hour shall be free.
- [c]b. For more than one hour and up to two hours, two dollars and fifty cents.
- [d]c. For more than two hours and up to three hours, three dollars and seventy-five cents.
- [e]d. For more than three hours and up to four hours, five dollars.
- [f]e. For more than four hours and up to five hours, six dollars and fifty cents.
- [g]f. For more than five hours and up to six hours, eight dollars.
- [h]g. For more than six hours and up to seven hours, ten dollars.
- [i]h. For more than seven hours and up to eight hours, twelve dollars.
- [j]i. For more than eight hours and up to nine hours, fourteen dollars.

[k]j. For more than nine hours and up to ten hours, sixteen dollars.

[l]k. For more than ten hours and up to eleven hours, eighteen dollars.

[m]l. For more than eleven hours and up to twelve hours, twenty dollars.

(2) The following rates shall apply to the Spring Street Municipal Parking Garage between the hours of 9:00 P.M. and 9:00 A.M. seven days per week, unless otherwise indicated below:

a. Every hour or any part thereof shall be twenty-five cents.

[(3) The following rates shall apply to the Spring Street Municipal Parking Garage New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day unless otherwise indicated below:]

[a. Every hour or any part thereof shall be twenty-five cents.]

(3) Special event and holiday rates may be implemented upon Resolution by the Mayor and Council.

(4) Any person who has lost or is otherwise unable to produce his parking ticket upon request as said person leaves the parking facility shall pay the accumulated fee based upon the above-referenced schedule from [9:00 A.M.] the time of entry as verified by Parking personnel from a time and date-stamped video to the time said person departs the parking lot.

Section 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be applicable within Princeton upon its passage and publication and shall become a part of the new Princeton Code once completed and adopted.

Section 3. The parking fee structure in this Ordinance shall take effect upon installation of the new parking garage access control system, or by October 1, 2015, whichever is sooner.

The purpose of the ordinance is to implement one hour free parking at the Spring Street Municipal Parking Garage for all garage customers to replace the current system of thirty minutes free parking for all users and two hours free parking for Princeton Public Library (PPL) patrons upon validation by PPL staff and processing by Municipal Parking Garage employees.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of Princeton held on August 10, 2015 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held at the Princeton Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street on September 15, 2015 which begins at 7:00 p.m.
