

**AN ORDINANCE BY PRINCETON
REGULATING PARKING ALONG
RIVERSIDE DRIVE WEST IN THE
VICINITY OF PROSPECT AVENUE AND
AMENDING THE “CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY, 1968”.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-23.1 of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey” (Code) establishing no stopping or standing zones upon certain streets is hereby amended by adding the following new reference to Riverside Drive West:

Sec. 11-23.1. Prohibited at any time.

No person shall stop or stand a vehicle at any time upon any of the following streets or parts of streets:

Riverside Drive West. East side, from the northerly curb line of Prospect Avenue northerly to the Riverside Elementary School driveway.

Section 2. The appropriate no stopping or standing signs shall be posted to implement the requirements of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication, as required by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of Princeton held on August 10, 2015 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held at the Princeton Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street on August 24, 2015 which begins at 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the no stopping or standing zones for Riverside Drive West in the vicinity of the Riverside Elementary School driveway, in order to increase intersection sight distance in accordance with endorsements from Riverside Elementary School, the Princeton Police Department and the Traffic Safety Committee. The net effect of these changes will be the loss of three parking spaces north of Prospect Avenue.
