

**2016-03 AN ORDINANCE BY
PRINCETON REGULATING PARKING
ALONG MOUNT LUCAS ROAD AND
AMENDING THE "CODE OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY, 1968"**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Princeton’s Complete Streets policy, several improvements were implemented as part of the recently completed Mount Lucas Road capital improvement project, such as on-street bike lanes and associated roadway widening to accommodate on-street parking and bike lanes, multi-use paved paths and sidewalks, widening and curbing of the roadway; and

WHEREAS, due to these improvements it is necessary to amend the current no parking ordinance of the Code of the Township of Princeton.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-12 of the “Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey 1968” (Code) establishing no parking at any time is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11-12. Parking Prohibited at Any Time

No person shall park any vehicle on any of the following streets or parts of streets at any time:

Mount Lucas Road. East side, between Valley Road and a point one hundred and thirty feet north of the extension of the Laurel Road north curblin.

Mount Lucas Road. West side, between Valley Road and Cherry Hill Road.

Mount Lucas Road. West side, between a point from the north curblin of Cherry Hill Road to a distance one hundred and eighty feet north and from another point starting at the south curblin of Laurel Road and proceeding a distance of four hundred and ten feet south.

Mount Lucas Road. East side, between Jefferson Road south curblin and a point one hundred feet south.

Mount Lucas Road. East side, between Jefferson Road north curblin and a point two hundred and forty-five feet north.

Mount Lucas Road. East side, between Ewing Street south curblin and one hundred and eighty feet south.

Mount Lucas Road. West side, between Ewing Street and Laurel Road.

Mount Lucas Road. Both sides, between Ewing Street and Stuart Road East.

Section 2. The appropriate no parking signs have been or will be posted to implement the requirements of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and shall become part of the new Princeton Code once completed and adopted.

The purpose of the ordinance is to amend the no parking zones on Mount Lucas Road, in order to accommodate the on-street bike lanes, the new curbed street width and sight distance at the intersections in accordance with endorsements from the Princeton Police Department and the Traffic and Transportation Committee.
