

**2016-04 AN ORDINANCE BY
PRINCETON REGULATING
PARKING ALONG PROSPECT
AVENUE AND AMENDING THE
"CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1974"**

WHEREAS, in the current Code of the Borough of Princeton, on Prospect Avenue, between Harrison Street and Riverside Drive West, parking is prohibited on the north and south sides, from a point one hundred feet west of Harrison Street to a point one hundred feet east of Harrison Street; and

WHEREAS, 'No Parking' signs were previously posted on Prospect Avenue in close proximity of the center islands near the intersection with Cedar Lane to prohibit on-street parking near the islands; and

WHEREAS, the current Code of the Borough of Princeton does not a parking prohibition to support the signage.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-22(a)(1) of the "Code of the Borough of Princeton, New Jersey 1974" (Code) establishing no parking at any time is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 19-22. No parking zones

(a) No parking at any time.

(1) Designated. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following streets or parts thereof:

Prospect Avenue, north side, from a point one hundred feet west of Harrison Street to a point one hundred feet east of Harrison Street.

Prospect Avenue, north side, from Washington Road to Murray Place.

Prospect Avenue, south side from a point forty feet west of the westerly curblineline of Olden Street, extended, to a point forty feet east of the easterly curblineline of Olden Street, extended.

Prospect Avenue, south side, from a point one hundred feet west of Harrison Street to a point one hundred feet east of Harrison Street.

Prospect Avenue, south side, from Washington Road to a point seventy-one feet easterly.

Prospect Avenue, both sides, from a point one hundred and sixty-five feet west of Cedar Lane to a point one hundred and fifty feet east of Cedar Lane.

Section 2. The appropriate no parking signs have been posted to implement the

requirements of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and shall become part of the new Princeton Code once completed and adopted.

The purpose of the ordinance is to amend the no parking zones on Prospect Avenue in order to acknowledge the existing signed parking prohibition at the center islands near Cedar Lane in accordance with endorsements from the Princeton Police Department and the Traffic and Transportation Committee.
