

2016-17 **ORDINANCE BY PRINCETON
DESIGNATING TWO HANDICAPPED
PARKING SPACES ON JEFFERSON
ROAD AND AMENDING THE CODE OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF PRINCETON, NEW
JERSEY 1968.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-11.1 of the “Code of the Township Princeton, New Jersey 1968” (Code) establishing handicapped parking zones is amended as follows (additions are underlined; deletions are in [brackets]):

Sec. 11-11.1 Handicapped parking zones

Jefferson Road, East side, two spaces directly in front of house numbers 77 and

79

[Jefferson Road East side, one space directly in front of house numbers 69/71
Jefferson Road (Ord. No. 2014-2)]

Section 2. The appropriate handicapped signs and pavement markings shall be installed to implement the requirements of this Ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and shall become part of the new Princeton Code once completed and adopted.

The purpose of the ordinance is to add two handicapped spaces at 77/79 Jefferson Road and to rescind one handicapped space at 69/71 Jefferson Road in accordance with endorsements from the Princeton Police Department and the Traffic Safety Committee.
