

2016-23 ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$690,000 FROM
THE SEWER TRUST FUND FOR VARIOUS SEWER
IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY PRINCETON, IN THE COUNTY
OF MERCER, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF PRINCETON, IN THE COUNTY OF
MERCER, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$690,000 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Trust Fund of Princeton, in the County of Mercer, New Jersey ("Princeton") for various sewer improvements, consisting of sanitary sewer system repairs, improvements to the pumping stations, repairs and improvements at the River Road Site, the acquisition of sewer maintenance equipment, landfill management engineering, the funding of improvements under the Joint Funding Agreement with USGS for stream flow gauge, New Holland Backhoe, 5/7 yard dump truck with plow and sander, upgrades to infiltration/inflow equipment, inspection and cleaning of sewers in easements, the acquisition of utility trucks, pickup trucks with plows and sander, and a kubota tractor, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures incidental thereto.

Section 2. Princeton hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of Princeton is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government

Services.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.

STATEMENT

The bond ordinance published herewith has been finally adopted by the Mayor and Council of Princeton on April 25, 2016 and the 20-day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement.
