

**2016-29 AN ORDINANCE BY THE
MUNICIPALITY OF PRINCETON
PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13
AUTHORIZING AN EASEMENT FOR THE
BENEFIT OF BLOCK 9902, LOTS 10 AND 11,
PRINCETON TAX MAP.**

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2015, the Municipality of Princeton (“Princeton”) acquired title to Block 9902, Lot 9.02, Princeton Tax Map (former D’Ambrisi Property) as additional open space adjacent to the Princeton Battlefield; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with funding provided by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Green Acres, Princeton agreed to provide an Access Easement for adjacent properties designated as Block 9902, Lots 10 and 11, Princeton Tax Map; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey local land and buildings law, *NJSA 40A:12-13 et seq.* permit the grant of an access easement to said adjacent properties for the benefit of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of Princeton, as follows:

1. The Mayor and Clerk of the Municipality of Princeton are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Grant of Access Easement for the benefit of Block 9902, Lots 10 and 11, Princeton Tax Map to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. The Grant of Access Easement hereby authorizes on file in the Office of the Municipal Clerk and may be inspected during regular office hours.

2. A certified copy of this Ordinance once adopted shall be furnished by the Municipal Clerk together with the Grant of Access Easement for execution to the following:

3. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication as provided for by law.

ORDINANCE PURPOSE

The purpose of this Ordinance is to provide an ingress, egress and regress easement over the former D’Ambrisi property (Block 9902, Lot 9.02) to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection for adjacent Lots 10 and 11, Princeton Tax Map.
