

Ordinance #2017-26
**AN ORDINANCE BY PRINCETON
CANCELLING SPECIAL
ASSESSMENTS FOR THE
RECONSTRUCTION OR
INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALKS
ALONG MOORE STREET, PARK
PLACE, VANDEVENTER AVENUE,
WILLOW STREET AND
AUTHORIZING THE COST OF SAID
IMPROVEMENTS AS A GENERAL
IMPROVEMENT.**

WHEREAS, Princeton (hereinafter referred to as the “Municipality”) adopted Ordinance 2013-23 authorizing as a local improvement the reconstruction of sidewalks along Moore Street, Park Place, Vandeventer Avenue and Willow Street; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinances provided for a special assessment of 50% of the cost of the reconstructed or new sidewalks to the owners of real property abutting said sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality has now determined to pay for the cost of the reconstructed or new sidewalks along the above-referenced streets as a general improvement and wish, therefore, to cancel any special assessments to the abutting property owners.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of Princeton as follows:

1. The Municipality hereby cancels the special assessments provided for in Ordinance No. 2013-23.
2. The Municipality has determined that the cost of the reconstruction or installation of new sidewalks provided for in said ordinance shall be borne as a general improvement by the Municipality.
3. Upon final adoption of this ordinance, a certified true copy shall be furnished to the Municipalities Chief Finance Officer and Municipal Clerk who are hereby authorized and

directed to cancel any special assessment which would otherwise have been levied pursuant to said Ordinance.

4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided for by law.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Mayor and Council of Princeton held on May 8, 2017 and will be further considered for final passage after a public hearing thereon at a meeting of said Mayor and Council to be held in the Main Meeting Room at the Princeton Municipal Complex, 400 Witherspoon Street on June 12, 2017 beginning at 7:00 p.m., and during the week prior and up to and including the date of such meeting, a copy of said ordinance shall be made available free of charge at the Clerk's Office to the members of the general public who shall request the same.
