

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A
PENALTY FOR DOG BITES OR
ATTACKS AND AMENDING THE
"CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF
PRINCETON, NEW JERSEY, 1968"**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of the Princeton as follows:

1. Chapter VI of the "Code of the Township of Princeton, New Jersey, 1968" which establishes regulations for dogs within said Township is amended by adding thereto a NEW Section 6-4.1 establishing penalties for persons who own, keep or harbor any dog creating an annoyance or injury to persons or property and shall read as follows:

Sec. 6-4.1. Same - Penalty.

Any person who shall violate any provisions of Section 6-4 concerning having a dog creating an annoyance or injury to persons or property shall be punished by the following fines:

- (a) For the first offense: two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars; and
 - (b) For the second and subsequent offenses: f i v e h u n d r e d
(\$500.00) dollars.
2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, publication as provided for by law.
